BASIC FACTS ABOUT CROATIA



Total area: 56,542 km2

Capital city: Zagreb (780,000

inhabitants)

Population: 4.3 million

Labor force: 1.7 million

Unemployment: 16.6%

GDP per capita: 12.971€ (2012)

Average net salary: 720 EUR

POLITICAL SYSTEM

- Parliamentary republic
- President elected by popular vote for a fiveyear term (last in 2010)
- Parliament elected from party lists by popular vote for a four-year term (last in 2011)
- ▶ 11 MEPs

ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION



20 Counties + City of Zagreb

County territory divided into:

- ▶ 128 towns
- 428 municipalities

Special status: City of Zagreb

Smallest municipality:

Civljane – 137 residents

Smallest town:

Komiza – 1677 residents

MUNICIPALITIES (428)

- 30,8% of total population of Croatia lives in municipalities
- Over 50% of all municipalities are below the population of 3,000
- Many municipalities suffer from inadequate human and fiscal capacity for public service provision

Registration: 2002

Members: 280

Employees: 3

Management: Assembly & Management Board (20 members)

Budget: around 130.000€/year

Membership Fee: Based on tax revenues (min 300€, max 1500€/year)

FOCUS AREAS

- Legal counselling
- Advocacy & lobby
- International facilitation
- Watchdoging of the legal framework related to local self- government
- Dissemination of information
- Training

Local Authorities' Competences

- Management and organisation of the settlement
- Housing
- Spatial and urban planning

- Fire fighting, civil defence, traffic management

TAXES & FINANCING

- 49, 5 % of the collected income tax is used by the municipalities
- 9% of income tax used by counties for elementary schools, high schools, social and health security
- Real estate purchase tax (5%) 60% used by the municipality
- Local surtax (0-10%) fully used by municipality
- Building permits (communal contribution)
- Utility charges (dedicated revenue)
- Holiday homes tax used by the municipality

State of Play

- Disability long lasting, physical, mental, intellectual or sensor damages which can, in interaction with different obstacles, prevent a person's full and efficient participation in the society on an equal level with the others (UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities)
- Not just a person's damage but the relation of the damage with the environment – society creates disability through its inadequate integration measures, or removes it through adequate integration measures

Numbers

- 520.437 perons with disabilities in Croatia (12% of population)
- ▶ 100.000 persons with some kind of disability is in the social care system – 2,2% of population and 20 % of all persons with disabilities

- Constitution
- Strategy for Achieving Equal Opportunities for Persons with Disabilities (2007 – 2015)
- Declaration on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (2005)
- Law on professional Rehabilitation and Employment of Persons with Disabilities
- Law on Social Care

Institutions

- Ombudsperson for persons with disabilities
- Ministry of Social Policy and Youth
- Local and regional authorities
- Croatian Employment Authority

- Croatian Institute for Pension Insurance

Social Rights

- Personal disability fee monthly 200€
- Addition for help and care (50 70 € monthly)
- Addition until employment (up to 50 € monthly)
- Right of Parent/Carer (350 400 € monthly + social and health benefits paid)
- Right to expert help to the family
- Early Intervention (children)
- Assisted integration in education
- Journey rights (full, part-time and occasional)
- Accomodation
- Help and care in the house
- Assistance in jobs and employment

CIVIL SOCIETY


- 10 national networks of disability NGOs
- Present in EDF (European Disability forum)
- Several thousands of disability NGOs
- Present in the Council for Civil Society Development
- Present in Social Entrepreneurship and social farming
- Financed by the state over 10.000.000 € in projects and administrative grants
- Financed by the local level over 15.000.000 € in all the units together

Conclusions

- Good administrative framework
- Clear goals set for the future
- Respect and implementation of international documents and conventions
- ESF planned for persons with disabilities
- Very large number of users lacking funds
- Need for more entrepreneurial approach to include full social inclusion that would be sustainable
- Need for more development funds to complement social care
